Sustainability fighting hunger and reducing food waste

Our Community Food Pantry plays a vital role in reducing food waste through our strong partnerships with local supermarkets and larger food rescue organisations. Our dedicated volunteer drivers visit these stores multiple times a week, collecting overstocked items, food nearing expiration, and more. This initiative not only prevents food from going to waste but also provides crucial support to our neighbours facing hunger.

In the past year, the Community Food Pantry has rescued over 40,000 kg of fruit, vegetables, and bakery items, diverting them from landfill and instead delivering them to families in need.

We're also committed to recycling plastic, paper, and boxes, benefiting both our community and the environment. Fresh produce and baked goods find their way to local tables, while items unsuitable for human consumption are given to local farmers for animal feed or compost, helping to grow even more fruits and vegetables.
